### Media, Techniques, and Processes

- Expands use of different materials, media, technology, techniques, and processes
- Communicates ideas and emotions in artwork

### Structures and Functions

- Analyzes elements of art and principles of design in two- and three-dimensional artwork

### Subject Matter, Symbols, and Ideas

- Considers, compares, and applies subject matter, symbols and ideas from different sources

### History and Culture

- Identifies characteristics representing various artists, cultures, and historical periods

### Characteristics and Merits of Work

- Discusses cultural and aesthetic implications in both contemporary and historical artwork

### Connections to Other Disciplines

- Describes how principles of design are interrelated with other disciplines

### Technology Integration

- Identifies characteristics of technological tools that resolve a visual problem
