Media, Techniques, and Processes

- Expresses experiences and ideas, and reflects craftsmanship and competency in artwork

Structures and Functions

- Demonstrates how elements of art and principles of design fulfill a particular purpose
- Applies elements of art and principles of design to communicate ideas

Subject Matter, Symbols, and Ideas

- Examines artwork in progress and revises for clarity
- Uses variety of sources for subject matter, symbols, and ideas in artwork

History and Culture

- Compares and contrasts social, cultural, ecological, religious, and political conditions in artwork
- Describes cultural and historical function and meaning
- Recognizes significant cultural and artistic heritages

Characteristics and Merits of Work

- Uses terminology in describing artwork
- Responds to and interprets identified artwork
- Evaluates artwork using a formal system

Connections to Other Disciplines

- Describes ways visual arts relate to other disciplines
- Identifies potential career and leisure pursuits in the arts
- Explores the idea that art and other disciplines use problem-solving techniques

Technology Integration

- Creates original artwork by using a variety of technological tools
- Uses technological tools to access information and resource materials
