

Sarah Klenke Memorial Teaching Scholarship

Deadline for Entry: Entries should be postmarked on or before March 31, 2004.

Criteria: Applicants are required to meet the following criteria:

- Graduating Senior or High School Graduate enrolling in secondary schooling
- Desire to major in Education
- Average student, preference given to GPA between 2.0 and 3.0
- Participation in JROTC, Softball or Baseball

To Apply: Applicants should submit the following to be considered:

- Handwritten essay on why you are interested in Education as a major or career
- Letter from coach or teacher confirming participation in ROTC, Softball or Baseball
- Information on how to contact applicant following the award of the scholarship and applicant 's grade point average
- Photo (optional)
