

New Scholarship Program Available for Military Children: Homefront America, Inc., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to assisting military service members and their families, has partnered with the W. Daniel Tate Family and Sara's Hope Foundation to announce, *The American Patriot Freedom Scholarship Award*, an essay contest for military dependent children. Through the generosity and support of the W. Daniel Tate Family and Sara's Hope Foundation, Homefront America will award twenty individual \$1,000.00 scholarships to military dependent children as part of the essay contest. Scholarships awarded may be used to assist students with tuition, textbook purchases and related supplies/materials.

As part of The American Patriot Freedom Scholarship contest, applicants are required to submit an essay- maximum 500 words - on one of four topics which will be judged on content, spelling, grammar, and originality. Essay topics are:

- Through every adversity, there is an equal or better opportunity
- Why my Mom/Dad is a hero?
- Why America? It's their problem, not ours
- *What Freedom means to me*
