Reading:

- Reads twenty five or more books or book equivalents (1050L–1300L)
- Reads and comprehends 4 books about 1 issue or by 1 author or in 1 genre
- Reads and comprehends informational materials

Writing:

- Produces a report
- Writes a response to literature
- Creates a narrative account
- Writes a narrative procedure
- Writes a persuasive essay
- Writes a reflective essay

- Participates in one-to-one conferences
