

## Social Studies: Psychology

### **Citizenship**

- Exhibits sensitivity to attitudes and values of others
- Recognizes the social influence of groups on attitude development

### **Culture**

- Describes positive aspects of diversity.
- Analyzes why behaviors do not occur in isolation

### **Time, Continuity, and Change**

- Identifies classical and modern personality theorists
- Evaluates factors that affects one's view of self and the world

### **Space and Place**

- Describes the effects of interaction between people and the environment
- Explains how geographic location affects one's perception of the world

### **Individual Development and Identity**

- Analyzes factors that influence individual development
- Examines psychological and self-actualization needs

### **Individuals, Groups, and Institutions**

- Analyzes impact of group motives and values on the individual
- Applies conflict resolution techniques to a variety of scenarios

### **Production, Distribution, and Consumption**

- Examines the impact of psychological research on the economy
- Evaluates the cost of mental health care services

### **Power, Authority, and Governance**

- Identifies societal sanctions on unacceptable behavior
- Identifies laws which changed policies for the mentally challenged

### **Science, Technology, and Society**

- Evaluates psychology as a behavioral science
- Accesses sources of information pertaining to the field of psychology

### **Global Connections**

- Evaluates the effects of media on our perception of the world
- Analyzes the impact of global events on an individual
