- Generates a calendar and timeline of events

Space and Place

- Designs and constructs a map with a key
- Locates various cities, states, countries, and continents on a map

Individual Development and Identity

- Recognizes that people vary in abilities and talents
- Recognizes the need for personal goals

Individuals, Groups, and Institutions

- Explains individual's responsibility toward family and community
- Lists ways people depend on human resources and institutions

Production, Distribution, and Consumption

- Describes various jobs and careers
- Defines goods, services, workers, income, and consumers

Power, Authority, and Governance

- Explains rights and responsibilities
- Describes the need for laws

Science, Technology, and Society

- Names energy sources found in homes
- Identifies ways people can conserve natural resources

Global Connections

- Recognizes the impact of individuals on a global society
- Discusses how traditions and customs are transmitted
