

## Social Studies: Grade 4

### **Citizenship**

- Explains citizens' rights and responsibilities
- Examines ways to strengthen the common good

### **Culture**

- Explains the value of cultural diversity
- Identifies the influence of immigration and migration

### **Time, Continuity, and Change**

- Traces factors influencing population movement
- Explains the developmental states of a region

### **Space and Place**

- Uses geographic tools to gather and interpret data
- Explains how geographic factors influence historical events

### **Individual Development and Identity**

- Explores factors that contribute to one's identity
- Describes regional influences on daily lives

### **Individuals, Groups, and Institutions**

- Interprets groups and institutions' influence on society
- Describes institutions that serve needs of individuals and groups

### **Production, Distribution, and Consumption**

- Explains environmental factors that determine regional jobs
- Uses economic concepts and terms that describe the economy

### **Power, Authority, and Governance**

- Describes the purpose of government and its powers
- Identifies representative leaders and their roles

### **Science, Technology, and Society**

- Recognizes how regional needs influence technological choices
- Explains how major inventions affect society

### **Global Connections**

- Explains how regions are interdependent
- Explains the relationship among regional, state, and national interests
