Ancient and Medieval Civilizations

Citizenship

- Identifies roles and responsibilities of citizens
- Analyzes how opinion influences the shaping of public policy

Culture

- Identifies cultural contributions of individuals, groups, and societies
- Explains interaction of culture and religion

Time, Continuity, and Change

- Compares effects of inventions and ideas across civilizations
- Analyzes social change resulting from social conflict

Space and Place

- Applies geographic concepts to areas of study
- Describes influence of geographic factors

Individual Development and Identity

- Identifies how societal changes influence personal growth
- Describes how culture influences individual development

Individuals, Groups, and Institutions

- Analyzes the changing role of family
- Identifies major influences on development of civilizations

Production, Distribution, and Consumption

- Discusses impact of economic, technological, and social changes
- Analyzes development of economic systems

Power, Authority, and Governance

- Explains how historical events influenced participation in government
- Analyzes structures of civilizations

Science, Technology, and Society

- Describes how science and technology change the world
- Evaluates civilizations' use of technology

Global Connections

- Describes impact of cultural elements
- Demonstrates understanding of universal human rights
