### World Geography

#### **Citizenship**

- Identifies sources and examples of citizens' rights & responsibilities
- Defines and demonstrates the attributes of a global citizen

#### **Culture**

- Describes the concept of civilization and its key components
- Identifies commonalities and differences among cultures

#### **Time, Continuity, and Change**

- Uses key concepts to explain, analyze and show connections among patterns of historical change

#### **Space and Place**

- Uses geographic tools to collect, analyze and interpret data
- Analyzes the distribution and migration of populations

#### **Individual Development and Identity**

- Identifies influences on individuals' daily lives
- Explains influences on personal identity

#### **Individuals, Groups, and Institutions**

- Explains influence of groups and institutions on values and beliefs
- Describes roles of international and multinational organizations

#### **Production, Distribution, and Consumption**

- Identifies factors that contribute to economic development
- Analyzes impact of unequal distribution of wealth

#### **Power, Authority, and Governance**

- Analyzes roles and functions of political systems and organizations
- Evaluates responses to economic instability and political problems

#### **Science, Technology, and Society**

- Describes influence of culture on scientific and technological advancements
- Uses appropriate software for geographic data and simulations

#### **Global Connections**

- Shows how technology affects global interdependence
- Explores the causes and consequences of global issues
