World History - Middle Ages to the Present

Citizenship

- Discusses citizenship in tolerant societies
- Demonstrates how history sets the standards for citizenship

Culture

- Understands impact of international trade and industrial development
- Understands how beliefs and values contribute to culture

Time, Continuity, and Change

- Explains the historical development of forms of governments
- Describes how the perception of time affects culture and society

Space and Place

- Understands the uses of space in a given historical period
- Evaluates the effect of geography on the creation of a nation state

Individual Development and Identity

- Articulates how personal beliefs reflect attitudes toward government
- Examines personal beliefs about discrimination

Individuals, Groups, and Institutions

- Describes changes in belief systems over time
- Examines the roles of social institutions and status of social classes

Production, Distribution, and Consumption

- Identifies programs implemented to reverse economic decline
- Compares various economic philosophies

Power, Authority, and Governance

- Traces the impact of revolutions on governments
- Outlines the evolutions of power and influence of world organizations

Science, Technology, and Society

- Analyzes how beliefs shape scientific and technological change
- Explains effects of scientific & technological discoveries

Global Connections

- Explains how oppression and displacement affects the world
- Assesses the impact of the global market on cultures
