### Citizenship

- Explains how actions of citizens can affect the economic system
- Determines how economic policies stem from issues of public concern

### Culture

- Identifies the economic values and ideals of various cultures
- Describes how economics often determines class and status

### Time, Continuity, and Change

- Explains the historical development of the leading economic systems
- Uses economic indicators to predict and evaluate economic trends

### Space and Place

- Explains how economic patterns are affected by geography
- Describes how the earth's resources are used to meet people's needs

### Individual Development and Identity

- Determines how economics influence individual behavior
- Describes how socioeconomic factors impact personal opportunities

### Individuals, Groups, and Institutions

- Analyzes the role of economics in the formation of institutions and groups
- Explains how values influence a society's economic development

### Production, Distribution, and Consumption

- Identifies and defines economic terminology
- Traces the development of various economic systems

### Power, Authority, and Governance

- Explains the relationship between politics and economics
- Describes governmental regulations on international trade

### Science, Technology, and Society

- Explains how science and technology affect economic development
- Analyzes how technology affects a nation's work force and economy

### Global Connections

- Evaluates economic behaviors which foster global conflicts
- Cites examples to illustrate global economic interdependence
