2. Students will reflect upon the results of their experimentation and select materials to be used in final artwork.
3. Students examine works of art that depict seasons using a variety of techniques and media.
4. Students will create a work of art portraying a particular season using selected materials.
5. Submit final artwork and evidence of experimentation.
