1. **PURPOSE**

This interim guidance:

- 1.1. Implements the classification system under References (a) through (d).
- 1.2. Provides supplemental guidance to the DoD implementing issuance at Subchapter 1920 of Reference (c).
- 1.3. Prescribes procedures and assigns responsibility to the DoD Fourth Estate entities.

2. **PROCEDURES**

Requests for Changes to Classification (SC1920.7.1.). The DoD Fourth Estate entities with delegated classification authority shall send a request for changes to the NSPS classification structure to the DoD Civilian Personnel Management Service with a copy to the DA&M.

3. **EFFECTIVE DATE**

This interim guidance is effective immediately.
