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

1.1. The Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) serves the educational needs of the dependents of the military and civilian employees stationed abroad and in the continental United States. DoDEA's 54 secondary schools, enrolling approximately 14,000 students in grades 9-12, offer an education that is comparable to that found in US public schools. The requirements for this statement of work (SOW) address the instructional material needs for students and teachers for the history portion of the integrated 2-credit Honors 9 World History and Literature course, which covers prehistory/early civilizations to the end of the Middle Ages (circa 1500 C.E.).

**2.0 CONTRACT SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES**

2.1 DoDEA requires materials for teaching the history portion of Honors 9 World History and Literature. The student textbook must (1) be aligned to the DoDEA social studies standards, (2) integrate other academic subjects, including literature, geography and culture, into the text; and (3) cover major European and non-European civilizations—prehistory/early civilizations to the end of the Middle Ages (circa 1500 C.E.).
