



Principal's Highlights

Brewster Middle School is a model middle school for the state of North Carolina and was recognized as a National School of Excellence. The staff is devoted to supporting each of the essential elements of a middle school in order to provide students with a comprehensive, appropriate and challenging program. Teachers and students are organized on teams where they focus on both the affective and cognitive needs of the pre-adolescent. Students are provided with the opportunity to participate in PE, fine arts, performing arts and computer literacy.

Construction on the 120,000 sq. ft. building is proceeding and is scheduled to be completed in June 2001. Students and staff are excited about beginning SY 01-02 in the new building. Planning for moving 657 students, 65 staff members, and all of our equipment and materials is a true community effort.




Student schedules are now generated by WinSchool. Teachers are transitioning for a Macintosh-based grade book to WinSchool by the end of the school year.
