



Superintendent's Highlights

Robins AFB District enjoyed a successful 99-00. The DoDEA Strategic Plan focused the schools on improving instruction. Improvements can be seen in all areas. TerraNova results declined slightly but remain well above the baseline. The DoDEA Writing Assessment results indicated that 91% of the 5th Graders scored at the top two levels. Parent support remains exceptional.

More than 90% of parents grade our schools as A or B, above DoDEA averages. Parent satisfaction with their child's teachers was the highest rated item. Also, parent volunteer hours increased and have improved 264% over baseline. There were improvements in technology, as new computers were purchased. The Internet was available in classrooms, and the district rating improved to high tech. Staff development was a major emphasis. Teachers developed individual professional development plans and many worked together to improve instructional expertise. Staff worked on technology skills, scientific process, Literacy Collaborative, Developmental Therapy, and Reading Recovery. We are looking forward to a very interesting 2000-2001.

Goal 3: Student Achievement And Citizenship

Benchmark 3.10: Demonstrate student technological proficiency.....
The district rating increased to high tech on the STaR Survey. New computers were purchased and the Internet was delivered to classrooms. Improvement was seen in the student keyboarding program.

Achievement test scores showed steady progress in science and math. Staff was trained in the scientific method by GYSTC. Science fair results increased and special math and science field days were held.

Professional development was a major emphasis in 1999-2000. Teachers worked closely with principals to develop, implement, and evaluate Professional Development Plans. The staff received training in many areas, with major emphasis in technology, science, math, and literacy training.




Goal 10: Organizational Development

 More than 90% of parents graded the schools A or B, well above DoDEA. Parent volunteer hours increased 12% in 1999-2000, despite a 20% decline in enrollment. Parents supported many school activities, including their home reading program.
