



Principal's Highlights

Patch High School, located in Stuttgart, Germany enrolls 570 students in grades 7 through 12. We are well known for academic achievement and computer technology, being first in DoDDS-Europe to have its own web page. Of 50 DoDDS secondary schools, we placed third for total SAT scores worldwide and first in Europe. Our scores were the highest in DoDEA on the Terra Nova '99, and over 94% (Proficient and Distinguished) in grades 8 and 10 in the DoDEA Writing Assessment for 1999. Our TV Production classes create a daily-televised news program, shown on our internal TV network. Our AVID program has recently been recertified with distinction.

Parents and community members are an integral part of our successful volunteer program. They produced a successful "Follies", showcasing many of our talented students, and organized a college fair with more than 50 colleges represented. Athletic and Band Booster clubs add tremendous parental involvement. Our CWE program offers real-life job situations for students. We are proud of the high number of students enrolled in AP classes and taking AP tests.

Goal 3: Student Achievement And Citizenship
Benchmark 3.1: Increase Proficiency in Reading/Lang. Arts. and Soc. Studies....
Curriculum Standards guide teachers in planning lessons. Last year teachers created and this year revised common core syllabi. Writing across the curriculum is encouraged in each subject and students are encouraged to generate work on the computer. Our high test scores on the Terra Nova attests to our students proficiency in reading/language arts, social studies, and math.




Goal 4: Math And Science Achievement
Benchmark 4.2: Narrow Achievement Gap between Racial/Ethnic/Gender Grps.
Our AVID program is in its fifth year. Students increasing their GPA by 0.5 are recognized through Excel Awards. At least seven hours every two weeks are reserved in seminar for specific individual assistance. Math tutoring after school twice a week, and a six week SAT preparation class offered on the weekends provide students more instruction in math and language arts.

Goal 10: Organizational Development
Benchmark 10.7: Effective Communication Sys. for all DoDEA constituencies...
Parents come to the school first and third quarters creating an opportunity to see teachers about student's progress. Reports of student progress at Midquarter are encouraged. A weekly grade check is made to insure students are academically eligible to participate in sports. School and home communicate via email, telephone, and letters. A homework hotline is being planned.

Benchmark 10.8: Establish technology for teachers and administrators.....
Computer and TV Production classes provide exposure to electronic and technological advances. Each classroom has Microsoft Outlook capabilities. Teachers receive training to make the processing of grades more efficient and reduce the use of paper, learn to use the Internet for instruction, and Microsoft Outlook. A TV network is connected in most classrooms.
