




**Benchmark 10.7: Effective Communication Sys. for all DoDEA constituencies**

The largest audience was reached through the Base Information Channel with video/audio presentations of 95% of the schools presentations, special guests, and programs.




#### Benchmark 8.1: Implement/Evaluate Multi-Tiered School-Home Partnership


