



**Principal's Highlights**

Students at Seoul American High School won 27 ROTC scholarships and received four service academy appointments. Our students have continued their tradition of excellence by performing well above the DoDDS and national averages on the SAT.

Each quarter over 600 students were honored for academic achievement at our Renaissance Assemblies. The community supported this program with generous donations of time and awards. Our athletic teams won seven conference championships. The Lady Falcons finished second in Far East Volleyball and third in Far East Basketball.

Ninth and tenth graders each completed twenty hours of service learning. Seoul American High School received accreditation from the NCA for 1999-2000.

SAHS has successfully integrated technology into many classrooms. Students have participated in district technology initiatives in the seventh, ninth, and eleven grades. We have been able to upgrade most of our classroom computers and six of our staff received district technology grants.

**Goal 3: Student Achievement And Citizenship**

Faculty, mentors, students, and parents have been trained in Cornell Notes and are using these notes in classes across the curriculum. Sustained silent reading continues to take place during the first twenty minutes of seminar. Students' writing ability continues to be assessed by school-wide essay writing.

The members of a mentoring program provided by a minority men's fraternity have been trained in Cornell Notes and they utilize these notes in their mentoring role. AVID continues to address the needs of all students who are not living up to their potential.

**Goal 10: Organizational Development**

*Benchmark 10.7: Effective Communication Sys. for all DoDEA constituencies...*

E-mail has become our preferred method of communications and is indeed an effective system. Since all teachers, administrators, and families have instant access to each other, the constituents feel empowered. The school web page augments the e-mail system by providing classroom and school-wide information and a bank of past school communications.

*Benchmark 10.8: Establish technology for teachers and administrators.....*

The staff has been offered several sessions on the electronic mail, grading system, PowerPoint, and Excel. Several members of the staff have attended "Technology Team" training, which will improve the school's technological opportunities and web capabilities. English and Science have initiatives set by the Korea DSO. All classrooms now have NT computers.






