

Research Science Institute Summer 2012

DoDEA will sponsor three students to attend the 2012 Research Science Institute (RSI). Sponsored by the Center for Excellence in Education (CEE), the institute will take place on the campus of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) in the summer of 2012. The six-week residential summer program emphasizes advanced theory and research in mathematics, the sciences, and engineering. RSI is open to students who will complete their junior year of high school by June of 2012. DoDEA will pay round trip travel expenses for the three selected students. Expenses for lodging and meals are included as part of the RSI program. Information and guidance for applying can be found at the Center for Excellence in Education's website <http://www.cee.org>.

Please note the deadline for DoDEA students has been extended. Interested students should complete the online forms at <http://www.cee.org/apply-rsi>, by saving and then printing the screen of each section to compile a hardcopy of the application for submission along with all the required documentation to his/her principal by January 27, 2012.

Principals will review and forward the applications to the Deputy Area Superintendent of Instruction by February 3, 2012.

The Area Deputy Superintendents' Office will facilitate the selections at the Area level and forward the selected applications electronically to DoDEA Headquarters, no later than February 10, 2012.

The Center for Excellence in Education (CEE) will make the final selections. Notification for the selected participants will be forthcoming from DoDEA HQ and CEE in late spring.
