

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR NOMINEES

BOARD ELECTIONS:

- Deadline for filing is COB (1600) **September 4, 2018**
- Elections will be held **September 13, 2018** at each CLDS location, 0730-1600

RULES FOR CANDIDATES:

- Candidate Eligibility: Any active duty person or their spouse residing- in **permanent**, assigned family housing aboard the Camp Lejeune /Marine Corps Air Station, New River complex.
- A candidate cannot be an employee of the Camp Lejeune Dependents Schools in any capacity.
- Candidates must be nominated by one (1) eligible voter (defined as the legal active duty sponsor or spouse of at least one student legally enrolled in the Camp Lejeune Dependents Schools) at the time of the election.
- **Deadline for filing is 1600, September 4, 2018.**

ELECTIONEERING:

- There will be no campaigning on school property, exchanges or commissaries, MCCS activities, The Globe or Rotovue.
- Placement of flyers or signs on utility poles, military housing property or any other locations is prohibited.
- There will be no government funds expended in your campaign, i.e., government mailing or phones.

Board Member Responsibilities

Members of the Board should possess:

- personal integrity and good moral character.
- willingness and ability of assuming responsibility.
- the ability to intelligently debate their convictions.

Members of the Board should:

- attend all meetings and training sessions.
- discuss items presented on the agenda.
- make recommendations and suggestions on areas of improvement.
- suggest items for consideration.
- vote upon motions and resolutions.
- be familiar with site specific school handbook, Community School Improvement (CSI), PTO/PTA activities.
- be prepared and willing to devote a sufficient amount of time to the study of problems and issues of education and be able to interpret them to the community.
- participate in CLDS community activities.
- be a presence and available to the CLDS electorate.
- represent the interest of all parents and students at CLDS.

Members of the Board should not:

- be partisan in dealing with school matters and the education of CLDS students.
- represent partisan interests or personal ambitions.
- have direct contact, provide information or negotiate with union officials.
- have a role in disciplinary process for CLDS employees.
- individually speak on behalf of the board.
- have any financial interest in a company or organization that conducts business with the school system.
