Cadet Caiden Green Selected for Air Force ROTC Scholarship

Cadet Caiden Green is competitively selected to attend the Air Force ROTC program this summer at Colorado State University. The **J-100 AFJROTC Character-in-Leadership Scholarship** is a new, annual ROTC scholarship which recognizes the character and leadership developed as a cadet in Air Force JROTC. This initiative makes pursuing a commission in the United States Air Force while earning a college degree a reality for many cadets in the Air Force's most diverse program. It will provide **100** cadets a full four-year ROTC college scholarship, including room and board, at select Minority Serving Institutions (MSI), Historic Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) and Hispanic Serving Institutions (HSI).

Caiden is a senior cadet and has amassed an impressive academic record and near-perfect JROTC scores. He was promoted to Cadet Commander this semester to lead 45 cadets in the day-to-day running of the cadet group. Caiden earned four **Varsity Letters** in Soccer, Drill Team, Color Guard, and Marksmanship. A valued team member, Caiden served as Team Captain (Soccer) and as President of the Film Club. Caiden planned this year's annual Bataan Death March cadet event and started up a new "Raiders" cadet group to promote fitness and wellness among all cadets. Displaying the highest example of selfless service, he led his Cadet Corps by performing over **255 hours of community service**.
