# PBIS

## (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports)

- **What** is it? **When** and **Where** is it implemented?

PBIS focuses on managing behaviors by identifying appropriate behavioral expectations, teaching those behaviors, and reinforcing them across all environments at every moment. It is a positive behavior cultural shift.

- **Who** is PBIS for?


PBIS is for EVERYONE---any and all community Stakeholders (Leaders, Teachers, Parents, and Students); changing behavior through PBIS takes the effort of a “village.”

- **Why** PBIS?

Research shows that having positive behavior supports reduces suspensions, expulsions, and drop-out rates by lessening at-risk behavior.

- **How?**

It is unpacked in a systematic and structured fashion with clearly stated expectations, and benchmarked rewards and recognition events.
