## Read 180

Brewster Middle school is dedicated to helping students improve reading comprehension across the curriculum. One component of this effort is providing focused remediation to students who are below grade level in reading. We do this with our Read 180 program. Our goal in READ 180 is to help students improve their reading skills, which will also help students improve across the board in every subject.

Here at Brewster we offer Read 180 to all three grade levels. Students are chosen based on comprehensive needs assessment using data obtained from Test scores, SRI scores, and teacher referrals. Read 180 includes several types of instruction enabling us to focus on individual reading, writing, and grammar deficiencies using data based research and differentiated instruction. The class includes whole group instruction, small group instruction, instructional reading software, and independent reading evaluated by Reading Counts quizzes. We also focus on several learning

and reading strategies to help students increase their comprehension, reading fluency and writing skills.

Student progress is closely monitored by the teacher and discussed weekly with students. Students are expected to read at least 20-30 minutes each night and log their progress on their reading log. Incentives are offered to encourage student achievement.
