When We Last Met

- Recently completed training of administrators on instructional shifts for the rigor of the College and Career Ready Standards for Mathematics (CCRSM).
- Posted and reviewed contract submissions to support professional development for CCRSM implementation over a period of years; K-12.
- Initiated writing of the new mathematics units for grades K-5 and teacher orientation on the work ahead.



Advancing the Math Plan

- Procured a professional development contract for teachers to have systematic training on mathematics content over a period of years:
 - 2,875 PreK-5 teachers returned to schools two days early to participate in training;
 - Training continues every quarter during the school year to provide ongoing support for nearly 5,000 teachers.
- Units and lessons for all classrooms:
 - Grades K-5; all schools using cohesive content;
 - Over 3,500 units were shipped worldwide;
 - Procured a contract to support the writing of these units to improve use of material.



Adding Literacy to Implementation

- Implementation of the College and Career Ready Standards for Literacy for grades 6-12 will begin in school year 2016-17:
 - Orientation and engagement of district superintendents in planning and decisions already underway
 - Begin module training for all area/district superintendents and principals on the instructional shifts within the literacy standards in January 2016
 - Engaging 1,865 educators in grade 6-12 in professional learning around the standards in Fall 2016
 - Begin teaching the standards in classrooms, starting with grades 6–12 and including all content areas in January 2017



Assessment Planning Begins

- Procured new assessment system — Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers:
 - Most DoDEA schools will assess online
 - Includes a suite of assessment tools for grades 3–8
- Transition planning has begun, starting with establishing the infrastructure to support test delivery to schools and to analyze data and create reports.
- Policy updates to align our test administration policy, practices and guidelines with the new assessments.
