DoDEA Student Dress Code

The Office of Education Policy and Operations (HQ) in collaboration with the Civil Rights Program developed a proposed DoDEA-wide student dress code. In an effort to ensure we have wide-spread stakeholder engagement, a 30-day commenting period is being offered to allow stakeholders an opportunity to review/comment on the proposed dress code. All comments are to be sent to studentdresscode@dodea.edu. The Education Policy and Operations division will maintain the student dress code mailbox guaranteeing that all comments are shared with the Civil Rights Steering Committee. Visitor Control

Starting immediately, visitors will have to show their ID before being buzzed into the facility. When the visitor arrives in the office the visitor will need to give the clerk his or her ID to verify that that person is authorized to pick up the child in question. If a visitor needs to leave the main office, they will need to leave their ID with the front desk and obtain a Visitor Pass. At the conclusion of their visit, they will return to the main office, hand in their Visitor Pass, and retrieve their ID card.
