Criteria for “Student of the Month”: The Student of the Month program is meant to promote success in and out of the classroom. To be a winner, a student must be a well-respected citizen and balance many different areas of academic life. A student must embody outstanding characteristics both as a student and as a citizen of the school community. The student must be able to handle many different aspects of student life while maintaining excellence in both character and integrity.

This award is designed to recognize and select students who promote and take pride in Ft. Campbell High School and in themselves.

Nomination Criteria: The student will exemplify character, respect and academic achievement in and out of the classroom. A student cannot receive the award more than once within a year. Students will be nominated by faculty and administration each month. Each month the staff will be reminded of the nominations and sent a link to complete the nomination application. Each staff member can only nominate one (1) student per month per grade.

Selections: Two students from each grade will be selected each month. The selected students’ name, bio and picture will be showcased during the month of recognition on the school website. The students will also be highlighted on Facebook and in the Falcon Flyer. The administration will also present a Student of the Month certificate and gift card to the student winners.
