## SUBJECT: Uniform Wear Policy

- 1- Proper uniform wear is a vital part of our JROTC program. In order to pass this course, cadets must wear the uniform as prescribed in cadet reference manual on designated dates for inspections, competitions, parades and other departmental activities. The uniform will be worn in its entirety for the duration of the school day (except during PE). Wearing of the uniform is a class assignment and constitutes 34% of the overall grade for the course. Exceptions to this policy will be granted in advance, by the instructor, on a case by case basis. Turning the uniform in to the cleaners is not a valid reason for not wearing the uniform. Cadets assigned to “In School Suspension” are also required to wear the uniform on the designated day. Those cadets will be inspected by one of the JROTC instructors. If a cadet habitually fails to wear the uniform a parent teacher conference will be scheduled and consideration will be given to removing the student from the JROTC program. ***IAW the Student Handbook they are responsible for making up the assignment within the next 5 days of school.***
- 2- Except under unusual circumstances and/or formal JROTC events after school, cadets should go home and change into civilian clothes before going anywhere else. Any exception to this policy should be cleared through the cadet’s JROTC instructor. Improper wear of the uniform, at any time during the day may result in a reduction of rank or removal from leadership position. i.e. removing ties, letting hair down etc.
- 3- The JROTC department will pay for the first alterations made to the uniforms, but these alterations **must** be made at **G & H Sewing Shop** (270) 352-1117, 1395 N. Wilson Rd, Radcliff, KY. Alterations made in any other location will be made at the expense of the cadet/parents.
- 4- Please, take care of your uniform and wear it proudly as a member of Fort Knox High School and the “Eagle” Battalion.
