**PebbleGo** is a PreK-3 database for reading and research. The PebbleGo databases make learning and improving reading and research skills fun, building on children's interest. Databases are simple to navigate and offer key reading supports such as read-along audio and word-by-word highlighting.

Symptom onset	Abrupt	Gradual
Fever	Usual	Rare
Aches	Usual	Slight
Chills	Fairly common	Uncommon
Fatigue, weakness	Usual	Sometimes
Sneezing	Sometimes	Common
Stuffy nose	Sometimes	Common
Sore throat	Sometimes	Common
Chest discomfort, cough	Common	Mild to moderate
Headache	Common	Rare


### INFORMATION CENTER INFO
