Principal's Report - Erin Grazak

- 100% Teacher and administration staff
- Student population currently listed as 524
- Biggest and best turnout for winter tryouts for Basketball, Cheer, Wrestling J.V and varsity teams.
- 40 plus for basketball and cheer and 26 plus for wrestling. Coaches will keep roughly 16 players but only 12 will dress.
- Far East jazz/Music in Japan week of November 26 ~ 30th
- Parent meeting for winter sports on Tuesday, November 27th at 17:00.
- Honor Role Award Presentation November 30th (1:35~3:00).
- Interim Testing for PARCC Dec 1st to 14th. 20 questions in 4 categories (Math/ELA) to be completed in class using chrome books.
- HOOP Coming winter sports: Pep rally November 28th (1:35~3:00), dance November 30th, and basketball games December 1st.
- SAT on Dec 1st

Garrison Commander's Report – Col. Scott Mueller

- Status of Population Expansion, up to 2000 growth increase over the last quarter.
- Attended school lunch to confirm the status of the food (mentioned previously in a town meeting that it was unhealthy). Food was decent and was better than expected.
- Recommends building cafeteria up instead of out.

Old Business:

- *Principal's feedback* on issues presented to the administration - Since last March's 2018 meeting, communication has been improving and the high school is now fully staffed. The school has been getting settled and now has some of their own traditions.
- *Chairman's update* on SAC open issues – There were no open issues.

Could it be a standing committee or subcommittee of SAC?
- *Pool Access for HHS Swim Team* – The Swim Team needs access to a pool with diving blocks. They need to know if they will be charged for the use of a pool and lifeguard. COL. Mueller will check with the CAC pools. Melody will check with Super Gym. However, the Super Gym has no blocks. Osan swim team students also need access to a pool at Humphreys, as well.
- *IAC Meeting representation* – a SAC designated member will attend the next IAC meeting on Thursday October 24th, 2018.
