SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Spanning over five military communities the DoDEA Europe East District, Rheinland- Pfalz, Germany serves the educational needs of military connected students whose parents are members of the Air Force, Army or civilians supporting the military mission. The district includes 32 schools and is currently the largest district in the Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA).

Kaiserslautern High School located on Vogelweh Air Station in Kaiserslautern, Germany is a comprehensive four year public high school enrolling approximately 700 students annually and is the third largest high school in Europe East District. Enrollment for SY 19-20 includes 161 seniors, 163 juniors, 197 sophomores, and 219 freshmen. The student body is culturally diverse and highly mobile with graduating seniors who have attended three or more high schools.

CURRICULUM

The academic program is organized on an alternating block schedule with a maximum course load of seven classes and a non-credit bearing seminar class. The schedule alternates with Red Day/White Day and classes are blocked into 85 minute periods. Block scheduling was instituted in 2008. Rigorous courses are offered through AP and Honor courses.

AP is an open-enrollment program.

Honors classes are offered in Language Arts 9 and 10

Concurrent enrollment through the University of Maryland Overseas program is offered to eligible juniors and seniors who are interested in earning college credit.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT RESULTS

In May 2019 251 students took AP exams.

A total of 414 exams were taken in 24 subjects.

Students earned a score of 3 or above on 224 exams.

54 percent of the AP exam scores were 3 or higher.

Official **class rank** is generated on the student’s transcript at the end of senior year. However, decile ranking can be submitted during semester one of senior year.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) CALCULATION

GPA is computed using the above quality points with AP courses weighted with a 5.0 point scale. Beginning with grade nine, all subjects are included in the GPA. DoDEA has a repeat course policy which allows students the opportunity to retake courses failed and use the most recent grade earned in the computation of the GPA. A minimum of 26 credits is required for the standard diploma. In addition, the student must have a 2.0 cumulative GPA. DoDEA offers an honors diploma to students who earn a 3.8+ cumulative GPA and successfully complete four AP classes.
