Dear Parent/Guardian:

Our spring 2021 College and Career Ready Standards (CCRS) Summative Assessments testing window begins on May 17, 2021 and closes on May 28, 2021. As we finalize our plans for this spring, we would like to share the following information with you.

Your child in 3rd, 4th, or 5th grade is scheduled to take the English-language arts (ELA)/literacy and mathematics tests on the following dates:

- Grades 3-5: May 17, 2021 – ELA/Literacy Summative Assessment #1
 May 18, 2021 – ELA/Literacy Summative Assessment #2
 May 19, 2021 – Math Summative Assessment #1
 May 20, 2021 – Math Summative Assessment #2
 May 21, 2021 – Math Summative Assessment #3

The CCRS Summative Assessments match the content and skills outlined in the standards that guide instruction in your child's classroom. The assessments are designed to measure real-world skills such as problem solving, critical thinking, and writing.

Beginning in school year 2020–21, DoDEA will administer the Alternate Blueprinting Option (ABO) version of the CCRS Summative Assessment. The ABO will have reduced test item counts and a corresponding reduction in testing time compared to assessments administered in prior years, but it will still support an overall scale score and performance level reporting.

The following table provides the tests and related testing times, by grade level, for each content area or subject that will be assessed in spring 2021.
