Background Information: Kubasaki High School is a Department of Defense School (DoDDS) serving the children of military service members and civilian employees living in Okinawa, Japan. Kubasaki offers 530 students dynamic and challenging courses of study complete with cultural opportunities that serve to create a unique academic and social experience. The school, opened on September 15, 1946, is located on Marine Corps Camp S. D. Butler, Okinawa, Japan. The current campus facility on Camp Foster was completed in 1964. Kubasaki students can pursue their passion and interest in the science, humanities, art and athletic fields as our school provides a comprehensive curriculum consisting of 19 Advanced Placement courses, general education and technical & career education coursework along with varied extracurricular opportunities. All courses are offered via a rotating block schedule of 7 classes of 84 minutes each, allowing our students an opportunity to earn 3.5 academic credits per semester for a total of 7 credits per year. In addition, all Kubasaki High School students must earn & maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA to meet graduation requirements. The average GPA for the class of 2021 is 3.34, with a high of 4.50 and a low of 2.08.
