Dear Parents,

Welcome to another GREAT school year! This letter contains important information about MC Perry Elementary School and DoDEA health room policies and procedures.

In September/October, I will begin annual health screenings for students, to include vision and hearing, Vision and hearing screening failure notices will be sent home to the parents.

DoDEA has specific immunization requirements necessary for continued enrollment in DoDEA schools. **Newly enrolled students have 30 days** from the date of registration to complete required immunizations. Currently enrolled students have **10 days** to complete any required immunizations they are missing. **If you receive a notice from me stating your child needs immunizations, please return the form/shot record to me with proof of immunization to avoid disenrollment. Updated immunization records/forms are due by the date written at the bottom of the letter/form that you received from me.**

If your child has allergies to foods or insect bites and requires an Epi-Pen or oral allergy medication at school, please provide a doctor-completed **Food Allergy Action Plan** in order to keep an Epi-Pen or allergy medication at school. If your child has a food allergy or is lactose intolerant, please provide a completed **Nutritional Plan for Children with Special Needs**. This form is also available in the school nurse's office.

If your child has asthma and requires an inhaler at school, please have the doctor complete an **Asthma Action Plan** and return it to me. All forms are available in the nurse's office. A new prescription/plan/order is required at the start of each school year.

All medications to be given at school must have a written doctor's order and all medications must be labeled to match the doctor's order. **No medication (prescription or over-the-counter, to include pain medications, essential oils, medicated cough drops, eye drops, etc.) can be given without a written doctor's order.** Forms are available in my office.

If your child's health status changes, please contact me so that your child's health record can be updated to reflect the change.

In order that we can reach you in an emergency, **please keep your contact numbers current.**

DoDEA has specific policies related to illness. If your child has a temperature of 100 degrees or higher during the school day, he/she may not remain in school. Also, your child may not return to school until he/she is fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication. Likewise, if your child has vomiting or diarrhea, he/she may not remain in school. Your child may not return to school until there is no vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours.

Medications



All medication administered at school must be


- **in the original prescription- labeled container**
- **have a completed medication form signed by the medical provider.**

This includes over the counter medications, essential oils, etc.

Students are not allowed to have any medication in their possession during the school day.

Medication forms can be picked up from the school nurse or medical provider.

Return to School After Illness



Temperatures of 100.0°F (37.7°C) or greater exclude students from school. **The student must be fever-free for 24 hours without use of fever-reducing medication before returning to school.**

Vomiting: student must remain home until vomiting resolves (**no further vomiting for 24 hours**)

Diarrhea: student must remain home until diarrhea resolves (**no further diarrhea for 24 hours**)

Alterations in Daily Activities

If your child has an injury or condition that does not allow them to participate in school activities, please provide a doctor's note.

Overview of School Health Services

The school nurse provides individualized health care for students, emphasizes health education at all levels, and utilizes available community and school resources to promote an overall healthy lifestyle for students, staff, and families. The school nurse:

- conducts health screenings
- monitors immunizations
- provides specialized health care services
- acts as medical resource for students, parents, and faculty
- provides individual health counseling
- evaluates and monitors communicable diseases

Immunizations



Current immunizations are required to attend DoDEA schools.

This includes the annual flu shot. If noncompliant, newly-enrolled students may be disenrolled 30 days after notification and currently enrolled students 10 days after notification.

Immunization Requirements

DTaP: 5 doses (1 dose after age 4)

Hepatitis A: 2 doses

Hepatitis B: 3 doses

MMR: 2 doses

Polio: 4 doses (1 dose after age 4)

Varicella: 2 doses

Annual Influenza Vaccine


Tdap: 2 doses (one dose given at age 11, other dose given at age 16)

Screenings



Students are screened for vision and hearing problems. A military dentist may screen our students. Parents/sponsors will be notified of any findings requiring intervention. Contact the school to request or decline screening services.
