Dear Parents,

During the month of October we will have several emergency drills which will meet some of our safety and security requirements for the school year. The following is a schedule of the drills that will take place:

October 12 – Mass Evacuation Drill: during this drill we will evacuate all students to the Sakura Theater.

October 15 – Lockdown Drill (Active Shooter Scenario): we are coordinating with PMO to conduct this drill. All classrooms will lockdown and students will be asked to remain silent until the all clear is given. Teachers will discuss with students beforehand how the drill works and will reassure students that it is only a drill.

October 17 – Fire Drill: this is our monthly fire drill. Students will be evacuated to designated areas such as the football field.

This information is being passed to you so that you can discuss it with your child(ren) so that they may be prepared for these drills. It is important for children to know that you are aware of the drills so that they may understand that it is only a practice.

On a different note, I would like to thank everyone for being flexible during our transition to the new drop off/pick up zones. We appreciate your cooperation and hope that this has made it easier for everyone. The barrier placed in the mornings in the front driveway will be removed starting next week. This was a temporary measure to ensure all parents were aware of the new traffic patterns. We will still have an attendant checking for access placards in the mornings and afternoons.

On October 10, 2018 at 0800, Mr. Jefferson and I will be hosting our monthly "Principals' Chat and Chew". More information will be sent regarding the location. Please join us to discuss ideas, concerns, or simply to get information about our schools.

NURSE'S NOTES October, 2018

Fall has arrived. **Halloween** is just around the corner. With that in mind, here are some timeless tips to keep your child safe and healthy during the trick or treat season:

- **Children should be accompanied by an adult or older sibling while trick or treating.**
- **Wear a light-colored or reflective costume for visibility.**
- **Make sure your child can see clearly through his/her mask.**
- **Check your child's costume for any parts that may cause him/her to trip and fall.**
- **Always have your child carry a flashlight to illuminate his/her path.**
- **Dress your child warmly beneath the costume if it is a chilly evening.**
- **Have an adult check all candy before eating.**
- **Limit candy intake to a few pieces at a time.**
- **Have your child brush his/her teeth after eating treats!**

Many children have serious food allergies that make trick or treat dangerous for them. Please read below about the Teal Pumpkin Project, a campaign to allow all children to safely participate in trick or treat activities.





Dear Parent/Guardian:

Last spring, your student took a new online assessment in literacy and/or mathematics that was aligned with DoDEA’s College and Career Ready Standards. This assessment, the College and Career Ready Standards (CCRS) Summative Assessment, is designed to measure your child's mastery of the new, rigorous college and career ready standards in Mathematics and Literacy. The assessment was administered in the following subjects and grades; Mathematics (Grades 3- 6), Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, and in Literacy for Grades 6-8 and for Grade 10.

All Iwakuni complex schools will host an Assessment Information Night for Parents on Wednesday, October 10, 2018 at 1700 in the MC Perry High School Auditorium. Parents will receive their child's Individual Student Report (ISR) for the assessments they took; see video messages from the DoDEA Director, Mr. Thomas Brady and DoDEA's Associate Director for Performance and Accountability, Dr. Judith Minor; and hear a presentation about the assessment and how to read your child's results.

We strongly encourage you to attend if you can. Parents who are unable to attend will receive their student's ISR in the mail following the Assessment Information Night.

The Assessment Information Night is open to all parents to hear more information about the assessment, even if your child did not take the assessment last spring.

We look forward to seeing you and talking with you at our Assessment Information Night

To order portraits of your children, go to www.cpiphoto.net or use the order form that will be sent home two or three days prior to our picture day(s).

- Make your package selection in advance.
- Order online or return the envelope and payment with your child **to the camera**. (**Do not return an order envelope to school if you order online.**)
- Your child, order envelope, and payment must arrive together at the camera if not ordering online.
- Please use *one envelope per student*, **NOT** one envelope for multiple children.
- Please make checks payable to *CAMPUS PHOTOGRAPHY*, **NOT** the school.
- Post-dated checks up to two weeks are accepted.
- Only pre-paid orders are produced and returned to school. Proofs are not provided on this program.
- Classroom composites (Elementary Grades only) may be added to your package by selecting add-on K.

Your advantages with the pre-pay program are; you receive the actual package, not just a small proof. Your satisfaction is guaranteed or you will receive a 100% refund. This program allows a faster return of the finished package.

Additional items such as the new Social Media Image (delivered via email), photo magnets, key chain photo fobs and 5x7 portraits can be added to any package. Be sure to look online for additional options.

- Gives you more energy! In general, children and teens who eat breakfast daily have more energy, do better in school and eat healthier throughout the day.
- Improves the ability to concentrate and learn. Eating breakfast on a regular basis has a positive influence on attention, concentration, memory and academic achievement.
- Fills the body with fiber, calcium, and other important nutrients.
- Helps to keep weight under control, have lower blood cholesterol levels and fewer absences from school.
- Children who eat a balanced breakfast have a lack of hunger and less complaints of stomach aches. Breakfast eaters feel full longer – often students who skip breakfast start to feel bad (stomach ache, headache, sleepy) by 9:30 in the morning.
- Improves mood. With sleeping, your body goes without food for a long time. Skipping breakfast can lead to a lack of energy and grumpiness!
