The Department of Defense Dependent Schools (DoDDS)

- DoDDS is an organizational element of the Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) with its headquarters in Arlington, VA.
- DoDDS was established in 1946 to provide K-12 education for the children of American military and DoD personnel stationed overseas.
- 143 schools, located in 12 countries .
- Student population is approximately 63,000.

Naples Middle High School

- Naples Middle High School is located on the US Navy Support Site base in Gricignano d'Aversa, Italy.
- Gricignano d'Aversa, Italy, is approximately 45 miles north of Naples, Italy, and is rich in Greek and Roman history.
- NMHS serves the educational needs of dependents of military and civilian sponsors who are serving with the US Military and NATO Joint Forces Command-South. Students are enrolled in our school from several NATO nations.

FACULTY:	Certified faculty and staff members, of whom 80% have Master's degrees or higher.
ENROLLMENT:	Grades 7 to 12: approximately 540.
SENIOR CLASS SIZE:	The senior class size varies between 55 and 85 students.
SCHOOL YEAR:	36 weeks divided into two semesters.
SCHEDULE:	A two-day block with four classes each day is offered. An 80-minute block schedule takes place each period. Middle school students take an advisory period and high school students take a seminar, offered every other day.

CLASS RANK & WEIGHTED GRADES

RANK: Class rankings on transcripts are based on cumulative grade point averages, including weighted grades students may have received from DoDDS or other school systems.

Advance Placement: Weighted by one point for any student who completes the course and takes the corresponding AP exam.

Honors courses: Not weighted.

Middle School students enrolled in high school math or world language courses will receive credit for the courses taken, but grades received will not be figured into their high school GPA.

DoDEA Honors Diploma

To receive this special diploma, the student must meet the standard graduation requirements and meet the following criteria:

- Earn a cumulative grade point average of 3.8 or higher.
- Successful completion of four Advanced Placement courses and participation in the requisite exams.
- Earn 0.5 credit in Economic Literacy in Career Technical Education, Social Studies, Science, or Mathematics.

CURRICULUM

- **Advanced Placement:** Courses offered at NMHS: US History, US Government/Comparative, Calculus AB, Statistics, Biology, Physics, English Literature, English Language, Italian, Spanish, Environmental Science, Studio Art, Psychology, World History, and Human Geography.
- **Honors Courses:** Offered in 9th and 10th grade- Language Arts.
- **Advanced Math Courses:** Advanced Quantitative Reasoning, Math Analysis (Pre-Calculus), AP Statistics, AP Calculus AB, Discrete Math and Financial Algebra.
