### Maturity/ Self-help skills

- \_\_\_ Dress self
- \_\_\_ Able to put on coat/ shoes etc. even if not able to button/zip or tie  
(Be able to zip clothing items)
- \_\_\_ Be able to separate from mom/family for most of the day
- \_\_\_ Able to sit for 15 min. quietly
- \_\_\_ Being able to say first and last name
- \_\_\_ Manage bathroom needs independently
- \_\_\_ Can walk in line
- \_\_\_ Can follow 2-3 step directions

### Fine motor/gross motor skills

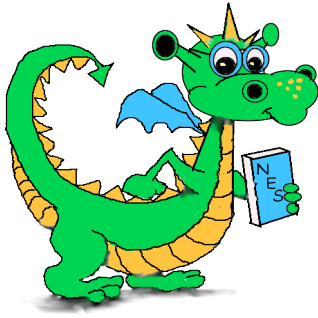
- \_\_\_ Be able to write some of the letters
- \_\_\_ Grip a pencil, crayon, or marker correctly  
(With thumb and forefinger supporting the tip)
- \_\_\_ Use scissors, glue, and other art materials with relative ease

### Pre-reading/math/ skills

- \_\_\_ Recognize first name. (Knows own name when shown)
- \_\_\_ Be able to write some of the letters.
- \_\_\_ Know some letters (Identify some letters of the alphabet)
- \_\_\_ Knows colors and some shapes
- \_\_\_ Counts to 10

#### Additional ideas to help your child be ready:

- ❖ Write child's first name using upper and lowercase letters
- ❖ Bounce a ball
- ❖ Classify objects according to their size, shape, and quantity
- ❖ Speak using complete sentences \*
- ❖ Recognize some common sight words, like stop
- ❖ Identify rhyming words
- ❖ Repeat full name, address, phone number and birthday
- ❖ Play independently or focus on one activity with a friend for up to ten minutes
- ❖ Follow directions \*
- ❖ Clean up after himself
- ❖ Listen to a story without interrupting \*
