SUBJECT: Cancellation of DoDEA Issuances

1. The six DoDEA Issuances below, are hereby cancelled.
 - a. DS Regulation 5792.9, "DoDDS Drug-Free Workplace," May 17, 1988, as amended. HR and OPLP are currently determining the policy guidance needed to replace this Issuance.
 - b. DoDEA Regulation 6800.1, "Domain Registration," October 28, 2004. There is no current guidance that replaced this Issuance.
 - c. DS Pacific Region Administrative Instruction 7240.1, "Tuition Rates," January 3, 1978. Current guidance can be found in DoDEA Administrative Instruction 7200.01, "DoDEA Tuition Program," October 13, 2017, as amended.
 - d. DoDEA Regulation 9000.2, "Competitive Sourcing Program Procedures," July 21, 2005. There is no current guidance that replaced this Issuance.
 - e. DoDEA Directive Type Memorandum 01-GC-001, "Settlement Agreements and Administrative Decisions/Orders," July 20, 2001. Current guidance can be found in DoDEA Regulation 5530.01, "DoDEA Settlement Agreements," August 2, 2018.
 - f. DoDEA Directive Type Memorandum 99-EEO-001, "Prevention of Sexual Harassment," October 14, 1999. Current guidance can be found in DoDEA Administrative Instruction 1443.02, "Prohibited Sexual, Sex-Based, and Other Related Abusive Misconduct Reporting and Response," February 21, 2019.
2. The above DoDEA Issuances are outdated and no longer needed for current operations.
3. The cancellation of these Issuances is effective from the date of this memorandum.
4. The Office of Operations, Plans, Legislation, and Policy will post this memorandum to the DoDEA Policy webpage within 10 days from the date of this cancellation notice. Any Issuances that references these cancelled Issuances, should update their citation within 30 days.
