LIBRARY CURBSIDE CHECKOUT

Beginning the week of October 5, 2020, the Fort Jackson DoDEA Schools will offer FREE Curbside Library Checkout. This service will be provided so that enrolled students may have access to high-quality literature during remote learning. We look forward to seeing you at checkout time!

Starting on October 7th, and every Wednesday until we return to school, your child will be able to pickup books from your school's library. Students will be able to checkout up to 3 books per week, but will be able to place up to 5 on hold. Students and parents will use our online library catalog to place books on hold. Books MUST be placed on hold no later than 4 p.m. the day before pickup. Books placed on hold after 4 p.m. are not guaranteed to be ready for next-day pick up. You may also bring books to return at the same time as pickup.

**Please note that each returned book will be out of circulation for 2 weeks, so not every book in your order may be available each week. As soon as the book is back in circulation, the book will be checked out to the next person in line.






STEP 5: Once signed in, you will see the home search screen. Your name will be in the top right corner. It is from here that you may search for books that you wish to place on hold. Once you type in your search fields, press "enter" to begin search. (If you need book recommendations, there are search suggestions listed in your Google Classroom.)



STEP 6: From the search results click on the book that you wish to check out.



STEP 7: Once you have opened the book information page, click the blue "Hold It" button on the right hand side.


The bad seed changes his mind about being bad and decides that he wants to be happy.

STEP 8: A new screen will ask you about your desired hold. Please use the pre-filled settings, for "As Soon As Possible." Then click "Save." Please remember that all returned books will be removed from circulation for 14 days and may not be available by the next scheduled pick-up day.

STEP 9: After clicking "Save" you will return to the book information screen. At the top of the page, there will be a message similar to the one below. *Please wait until you are notified before heading to the the school. This date does not reflect our scheduled pick-up days, or book availability.*

STEP 10: You will receive an email to your student's Google Mail when your items are ready to be picked up. Once you receive your confirmation email, you are ready to pick up! Make sure to bring any books to return, when you come for pick up!



HOW TO PICK UP:

1. Once you have received an email notification that your items are ready, you may head to the school on pickup day any time between 11:00-1:00.
2. Using the carpool lane, pull up to the first cone. Once at the cone, please share your student's name and return any books or materials to turn in. Your librarian will gather your books, and hand them to you. You are now free to enjoy reading your new books!



The health and safety of Ft. Jackson families is our top priority. To ensure that your experience of checking out books is safe, your school librarians will wear masks and gloves when checking out your books, as well as during the curbside pickup. All returned books will be removed from circulation for at least 14 days before being re-circulated.
