

Dress Code for Ramey Unit School

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Reference Policy: Student Dress Code

(DoDEA Administrative Instruction 2051.02, Student Rights and Responsibilities,” April 17, 2012)

Students are expected to dress in a manner that complies with the school’s dress code policy as directed in the DoDEA Administrative Instruction 2051.02, “Students Rights and Responsibilities,” Enclosure 2 (3,c,1) and Enclosure 2 (5,l).

The uniform policy still stands. In addition to the standard uniform, expansions for shirt choices for the remainder of the 2020-2021 School Year are noted below. **Further neither MS nor HS students are required to wear PE uniforms because there will not be access to lockers or locker rooms.**

Uniform shirts can be purchased by students from the front office when they

SHIRTS

Current policy:

Pre-Kindergarten – 5th grades:

Hunter Green colored, collared polo shirts only, with button placket front.

6th – 11th Grades:

Black colored, collared polo shirt only, with button placket front.

12th Grade:

Seniors will select their own color polo shirt.

Undershirts must be tucked in, not hanging out below polo shirt. This includes the sleeves, which may not extend beyond the uniform polo sleeves. Shirts must have bottom button fastened. With the exception of the school logo, emblems may be no larger than 2”x2”. No exaggerated, oversized polo shirts, or too small/tight polo shirts.

***Expansions for the remainder of the current school year are:

Pre-Kindergarten – 5th grades:

Ramey P.E. uniforms -OR-

Hunter green OR grey solid colored

collared polo shirts without school emblems OR plain t-shirts in these colors.

6th – 11th Grades:

White OR black solid colored

collared polo shirts without school emblems OR plain t-shirts in these colors.

12th Grade:

White, black, or class-selected solid colored

collared polo shirts without school emblems OR plain t-shirts in these colors.

SLACKS/SHORTS

Current policy, no expansions:

Pre-Kindergarten – 5th grades:

Khaki colored, plain, tailored slacks (tailored means not baggy, oversized, or skin tight).

6th – 12th Grades:

Khaki colored, plain tailored slacks (tailored means not baggy, oversized, or skin tight).

Shorts: may be no more than 4" above the knee.

SKIRTS/JUMPERS/DRESSES/OVERALLS

Current policy, no expansions:

Length must be no shorter than 4" above the knee.

No skin tight skirts/jumpers/dresses/overalls allowed.

Khaki colored (Pre-kindergarten – 5th Grades)

Khaki colored (6th – 12th Grades)

Overalls and jumpers allowed. Solid colors only, and either straps or buttons must be fastened; straps cannot dangle or be disconnected. Vest/skirt, vest/pants, vest/shorts combinations are acceptable. Vests must be the same color as bottoms.

JACKETS/SWEATERS

Current policy, no expansions:

Students may only use black jackets. The jacket must be in a solid color without large emblems. Students may wear school-sponsored jackets.

SHOES, SOCKS AND ACCESSORIES

Current policy, no expansions:

Closed toe shoes must be worn at all times. Flip flops, crocs, sandals, and other open shoes will not be allowed. Socks should not display shocking patterns or colors. This applies to all students, Pre-kindergarten – 12th grades. Sun glasses are to be worn

outside school buildings only.

HATS AND OTHER HEAD COVERINGS

Current policy, no expansions:

Hats, scarves, and other head coverings will not be allowed on campus. This applies to both males and females. Once students enter school grounds, hats must be removed and should be stowed in a backpack. **Please note that students will NOT have access to lockers during the school day.**

IMPORTANT NOTES

Extra clothing is NOT being loaned from the school to correct dress code violations for the remainder of the year. Students who are not in proper uniform will need to have clothing delivered to the pedestrian gate or be picked up to go home. The time out of class will be reported as an UNexcused absence.

Students must wear the school uniform Monday thru Thursday. On Fridays students are permitted to wear Ramey Sports team or organizational shirts (i.e. National Honor Society, Band, Cross-country, etc).

Parents and students are advised that the full uniform policy is expected to be in force in August of 2021 with NO expansions or exceptions.

Additional modifications or exceptions to the uniform may be enacted as deemed necessary by the Ramey School administration.
