

## AP Exam 2021 Administration Windows

As the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic continues to increase and affect educational systems across the country, the College Board has decided to provide AP testing options for schools in administering the AP Exams 2021 this spring. DoDEA students will have the opportunity to participate in the traditional in-person paper AP Exams during regular school hours in Administration 1. While we certainly advocate for testing during this administration window, students will have the opportunity to participate in make-up digital AP exams in Administration 2 and if needed Administration 3. We are hoping that only a small percentage of the total number of students will be taking the make-up digital AP exams and that the impact of nighttime testing will be minimized to a few students in Europe and Pacific. Additionally, AP students in DoDEA may be scheduled for make-up exams only if they were not able to participate in Administration 1.

There are 34 AP Exams available and only 25 of the AP exams are available in digital format. DoDEA will implement the System-wide AP Exam Schedule below to:

- (1) maximize the opportunities for DoDEA students to earn a college credit through participation in AP Exams while maintaining a safe testing environment for students
- (2) minimize the need for odd testing hours for AP examinees in the Pacific and Europe

### Start Times:

- Paper and pencil AP Exams and Chinese and Japanese AP Exams have **local start times** and can begin up to 1 hour after the official start time (i.e., 8–9 a.m. local time for morning exams, 12–1 p.m. local time for afternoon exams, and 2–3 p.m. local time for Physics C: Electricity and Magnetism).
- However, digital AP Exams have **synchronous start times** worldwide, and automatically begin at the same official start time.

### Exams with Digital Portfolios:

- College Board has extended the deadline for final digital submission of AP Art and Design portfolios and AP Computer Science Principles (CSP), AP Seminar, and AP Research performance tasks to Thursday, May 20, 2021, 11:59 p.m. EDT, to support students and teachers impacted by delayed school start dates. The AP Seminar end-of-course exam will be administered during the three administration windows.
