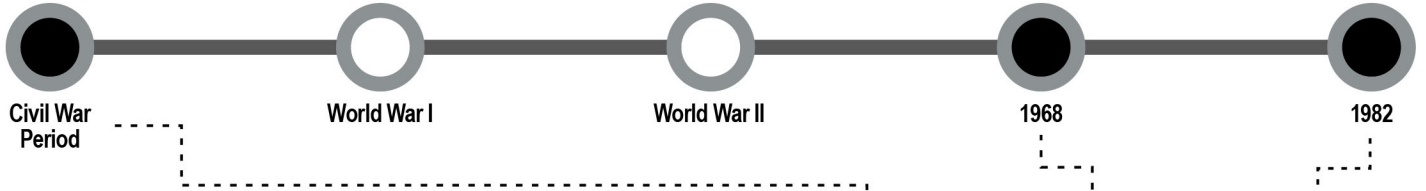


Portrait of Hispanic Active Duty Service Members
