Biography

Mr. Romero began his teaching career with Miami-Dade County Public Schools in Florida in 2006. He began working at Kendale Elementary where he taught 2nd through 5th grades during his time at that school. He then worked the next three years as a math coach at Laura C. Saunders Elementary in Florida City. During his time as an instructional coach, he was part of a team that raised the school from an F rating to a B rating based on standardized test scores. He then spent one year at South Dade Senior High School as an interim assistant principal. During his time in the Miami-Dade County Public School system Mr. Romero was Rookie Teacher of the Year and two-time Teacher of the Year as well as part of the iLead program in which he was recognized as one of the emerging leaders in education. Mr. Romero joined DoDEA in 2017 as a sixth-grade teacher at Diamond Elementary. He spent the next two years as a fifth-grade teacher in Diamond's new 21st century school. In 2019 he became the K-5 Math ISS for the Ft. Stewart/South Carolina Community Superintendent's Office where he supports the seven schools in the community in the area of math and professional learning.

Mr. Romero holds Bachelor of Science degree in Elementary Education from Florida International University in Miami and a Master of Arts in Educational Leadership from Nova Southeastern University in Ft. Lauderdale. He also earned a Specialist degree from Arkansas State University in Educational Leadership.

Mr. Romero is a veteran of the United State Navy where he served five years as an Aviation Hydraulic Mechanic on F/18 Hornets. He spent time at Cecil Field in Jacksonville, FL, and at NAS Oceana in Virginia Beach, VA. He completed three deployments during his time, one on the USS Eisenhower aircraft carrier and two aboard the USS Washington aircraft carrier.
